Tuesday, March 19 at Logan High School, 1500 Ranger Drive:

- If you have items that need to be unloaded, volunteers will be available to assist you at the south doors.
- Park in the field lot (runs parallel to the football field, behind the press box). You can also park in the middle and first rows in the lot by the baseball field.
- Volunteers will guide you to the gym.
- At the end of the event, volunteers will help load your vehicle.
