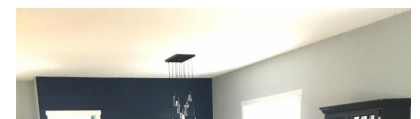
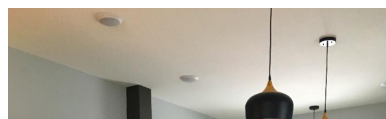
### Welcome Home to the Lyons Family!
