

Created your FSA ID

Your FSA ID, which is your account username and password, allows you to complete and update the FAFSA form. The FSA ID is your legal signature and should NOT be created or used by anyone other than you-not your parent, a school official or anyone else. You will use your FSA ID every year to fill out your FAFSA form and for the lifetime of your student loans. Couple of tips:

- Students need to create their own FSA ID to complete the FAFSA process.
- Parents will need to create their own FSA ID to complete the FAFSA process.
- An email address can only be associated with one account, an account you must have access to.
- Students...DO NOT use your school email address.
- You will need to create both the accounts at least a week prior to starting the FAFSA. It can take up to three to five days before the FSA ID's are verified.

Whether you're a student, parent, or borrower, you'll need to create your own account to manage the student loan journey.

What You Can Use Your Account For

- Filling out the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA®) form
- Signing your Master Promissory Note (MPN)
- Applying for repayment plans
- Completing loan counseling
- Using the Public Service Loan Forgiveness Help Tool

What You'll Need

- Social Security number
- Your own mobile phone number and/or email address

Next, enter your First Name, Middle Initial (if applicable), and Last Name as it appears on your Social Security card.

Enter your Date of Birth, type numbers only. For example: March 14, 1988 would be entered 03 14 1988

Enter your Social Security Number.

Double-check everything to make sure spellings are accurate and numbers are in the correct order. Click continue to move to the next step.

Step 1 of 7 Personal Information

I understand that I'll be required to certify that the information I provide to create an account (FSA ID) is true and correct and that I'm the individual I claim to be.

If I'm not the person I claim to be, I understand that I'm not authorized to proceed and that I should exit this form now. If I provide false or misleading information, I understand that I might be subject to a fine, prison time, or both.



Enter a Username.

Enter your email address. Use a permanent email that you check frequently. Students should **not** use their school email addresses.

Enter your email address a second time to confirm.

Enter a password. Must be at least 8 characters, have at least one number, and include upper case and lower case letters.

Confirm the password.

Make sure to write down your username and password. Then place them in a folder in a secure area with the rest of the FAFSA information. You will need them in future years. See last page where you can keep track of all your information.

Click on continue to go to the next step.



Next, enter your permanent address information.

Enter your mobile phone number, and then confirm the number. Make sure this is a number you have access to and check frequently.



It is recommended you check the agree box to receive text messages for account verification. Then click on continue to move to the next step.

Next, select if you want to receive required communications through email or postal mail.

Select if you want to receive optional communications by email or text message.



Choose language preference and then click continue.



Next is the completion of four challenge questions. Use the page at the end of this document to write down your answers.

Challenge Questions

Challenge questions and answers are used to retrieve your username or password if you forget them or if you need to unlock your account.

Note: Answers are not case-sensitive.

Next, Enable Two-Step Verification for both your phone and email. Click on Verify next to the method you are using.

You should receive an email or text message containing a secure code. A box will pop up for you to enter the code, then click continue.

If you choose to use an Authenticator, you will need to download an app from the mobile store on your phone. Next, scan the QR code or enter the key displayed on your screen. When you have the app set up click continue. Enter the secure code and then click finish.

Once the Authenticator is verified click on continue.

A back up code is generated automatically when you enable the two-step verification. Make sure you write down the code and keep it with the rest of your FAFSA information. Check the box and then click continue.



The final screen indicates that you have successfully completed your FSA ID! You should also receive a confirmation email.
